



Supplies:

- 1 small bag of Potting Soil
- 1 small bag of Cow Manure
- 3 small vine type Veggies or 1 Tomato
- 1 Container w/trellis

Trellised Veggie Project

Project Time: about 15 minutes

Project Cost: \$25.00

Fun, easy way to grow a vine type veggie or tomato on your patio!

Pour enough potting soil into the pot so that the plant will sit at the same level at the rim of the new pot as it did in the old pot (about 1 inch).

Remove the plant from the old pot. Hold the plant stalk between your thumb and four fingers. Turn the old pot upside down and tap on the bottom. The plant should come right out. Loosen the root system.

Space the veggies out evenly within the trellis area of the pot and pour soil around the sides of the plants until the level of the added soil is even with the top of the soil around the plants. Gently press down on the sides to anchor the plants. Add more soil, if needed. Water the potted plant thoroughly, watch it grow and harvest!
